paddle boarding in the bay, and look to your right and you'll see sweeping fairways lined with palm trees, dancing in the breeze.

Fans of air conditioning can grab a table inside where you'll find a large, stylish and cozy dining space with expansive floor-to-ceiling windows, a large green wall with colorful live plants, and a bar equipped with TV's for viewing sports.

Feast & Fareway also has a couple of vegan options, Benedict’s, and some sweet treats for those with a sweet tooth.
